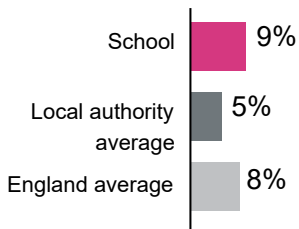

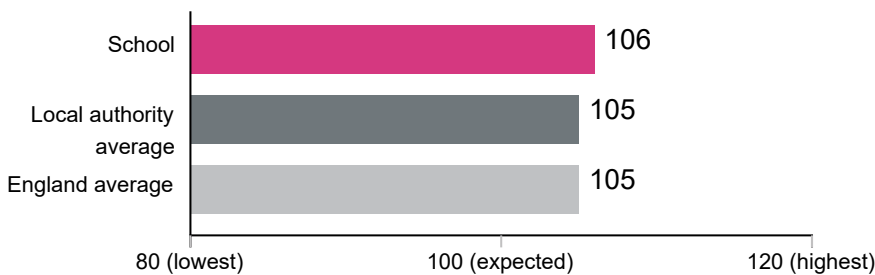
Pupils achieving at a higher standard in reading, writing and maths ?

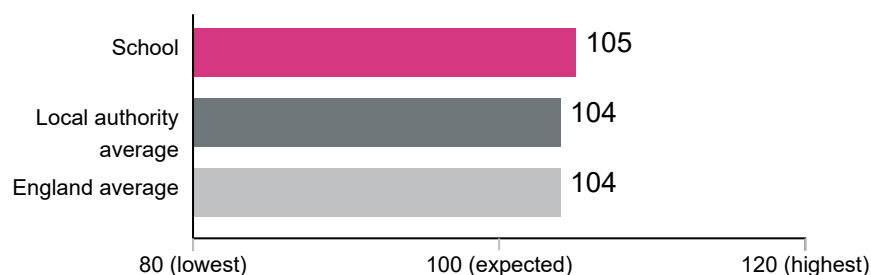
